

WHY A REVOLUTION³ RACE IN 2011?



AT REV3, WE WANT TO CREATE A FIRST-CLASS TRIATHLETE EXPERIENCE FOR YOU, YOUR TRIATHLON CLUB, AND FOR YOUR FAMILY & SUPPORTERS.

For you as an athlete:

- We created the Rev3 Age Group Race Series, offering to you, the top age group triathletes in the country, a total prize purse of \$20,000. The series **featured** races include:

Costa Rica Olympic Rev –Saturday, Feb. 19
 Knoxville Olympic Rev - Sunday, 15 May
 Quassy Half Rev - Sunday, 5 June

Portland Half Rev- Sunday, 10 July
 Cedar Point Full Rev - Sunday, 11 Sept.
 South Carolina Half Rev- Sunday, 9 Oct.

- Series prize money will be paid out to the top five overall age-group men and women who compete in a minimum of two featured races of varying distances (IE, 1 Olympic and 1 Half or 1 Half and 1 Full, etc). Athletes will only earn points for up to 3 of the featured events (must be one Olympic, one half, one Full), however if you place in 2 of the same distance, points will be earned for your highest placing at that distance. (IE, 1 Olympic, 2 half, 1 full, score will be of the Olympic, Full, and highest placing of the 2 halves).

SERIES EVENT SCORING :

Place	Points Earned	Place	Points Earned
1st place	500 points	6th place	100 points
2nd place	400 points	7th place	90 points
3rd place	310 points	8th place	80 points
4th place	230 points	9th place	70 points
5th place	160 points	10th place	60 points

This declining scale system helps to avoid ties in total race series points. For example, one 1st and one 3rd beats two 2nds.

Example: Johnny
 Knoxville Oly- 1st (500)
 Portland Half- 4th (230)
Total: 730

Jim
 Costa Rica Oly-4th (230)
 Quassy Half- 7th (90)
 Cedar Point Full-1st (500)
Total: 820

Joe
 Costa Rica Oly- 6th (100)
 Quassy Half- 3rd (310)
 Cedar Point Full- 2nd (400)
 South Carolina Half-2nd (400)
Total: 900

- In the scenario above, Joe would place first because he was able to use the South Carolina Half to better his placing at the half distance.

**In the case of a tie, the athlete who competed in the most Rev3 events will be given the advantage.*

**2nd tie breaker will be determined by the athlete who placed closest in percentage to the overall age group winner of the races they competed in.*
